Paul Imhoff said the School Board is working on the School Calendar, which is done in 3 year increments. It is set based on a survey done by parents.

The Board of Education will take action on the facilities plan at its December board meeting. It is approximately a \$300,000,000 plan that will take 15 years to implement fully. The first building to be worked on will be the High School. In March / April the community will again have opportunity for input. The plan is for a levy with all financing figured out to be on the November 2017 ballot for the city to vote on.

Paul also said he appreciates everything that is being done to support the two teachers at Hastings that are fighting cancer right now. The district will do all it can to support them and the staff at Hastings. PTO will put a plan together of how it can best help and get the rest of the students and parents involved in this effort.

Principal Report

Mike Robertson reported for the Principals. He also is working to help the teachers and staff in the upcoming time with all issues regarding the teachers with cancer. He will keep PTO updated on ways to help and get involved.
